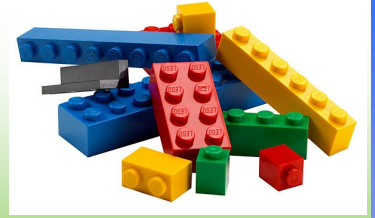
LOTTERY FUNDED
