Due to the large number of additional people/after school providers/changes made to pupils collection arrangements at the end of the day we have decided to put a system in place that should make it easier at the end of the day to ensure pupils go

home with the right person. This will also ensure that if the teacher is not seeing their class out for any reason that your instructions are easily available.

Forms have been emailed home earlier this week for you to complete if you would like to authorise anyone that does not have parental responsibility to collect your child. This will include after school providers, grandparents, or anyone other than Mum/ Dad/Carer that you wish to be able to collect your child. You can use this form for one off collections, or permanent arrangements, just state which on the form. You will need to fill in a new form each year - this form covers this year, but you can change your instructions at any time by completing a new form. You can either send in a paper copy, or take a photo of the form and email it to us at: office@scarning.norfolk.sch.uk - but we MUST have a signature on the form, and if it is emailed it must come from an email address we hold on file for you.

Please only call the school with a change of collection in an EMERGENCY situation, and by 2.45pm, so we can pass the message on.

Each class will keep a folder with these arrangements in, and the office will keep a copy on file too. We are going to allow 2 weeks for these forms to be completed, but from Monday 20th November you will be asked to complete the attached form for all changes to your child's collection. Please ensure you know the name of the person collection your child - if you just say Bob's mum we may have more than one Bob in that class.

Paper forms will always be available in the leaflet holders outside of the office, or available to download from our website. We hope you can understand why we are asking you to do this - any questions please ask at the office and we will come out and speak with you. Thank you.
